Bylaw Services: Dog Houses

Pet owners are legally responsible to provide pets with adequate shelter, and for outdoors dogs, this means having a proper dog house. These recommendations can help create a healthy, comfortable space for your beloved pup(s).

- **Appropriate size** A dog house must reflect the breed, age, and personality of a dog to ensure comfort and durability. There must be enough room for the dog to lay conformably, stand-up, and be able to move around. If multiple dogs are using the same house, adjust the size accordingly.
- Protection from elements
 - Our northern winters require sufficient insulation and ventilation in dog houses and even more so if your pet is older, a puppy, or ill. Wood is a great insulator (not treated lumber as this could make your dog sick if chewed on or ingested). If your dog chews on wood, try covering the exposed wood with sheet metal or heavy plastic.
 - Ensure the dog house is slightly raised from the ground to keep moisture mold, bacteria, and bugs out.
 - Have a plastic flap over the entrance to make it easy for your dog to get in and out and shield them weather elements.
- Upkeep
 - Make sure your dog's house can be moved if needed.
 - Having a hinged roof allows easy access for cleaning and maintenance of the structure as opposed to crawling inside to tidy up.
- **Bedding-** Regularly replaced straw serves best for dog houses, as it prevents moisture therefore ridding bacteria. A layer of woodchips underneath can provide limited drainage to prevent mold growth before the straw is replaced.
